Students showcase smart, AI solutions at school science fair

Chennai: Volcano models made of cardboard are no longer the top draw at science exhibitions in schools. Now, they have been replaced with prototypes of hydraulic robotic arms, AI face detection cameras and wind-powered trucks.

The inter-district science exhibition 'Laser 25' hosted by Madras Christian College Higher Secondary School for classes VI-XII on Wednesday, showcased the engineering aptitude of students. A robot to assist the elderly, a fall detection system, and automatic attendance markers were among prototypes on display from about 62 schools in Chennai, Tiruvallur, Kanchipuram, and Chengalpattu.

The participants, in groups of two to three, were tasked with designing prototypes of ideas involving innova-

tive technology such as AI, disaster management, and organic farming.

They were divided into 3 categories - Class XI-XII; IX-X; and VI-VII. M J Rayyan of Class VI, SBOA School and Junior College, who won the third prize in the 'topics' category along with Kahanshwa S for his 'smart saver system', said, "My mother once witnessed an accident and won-

dered if there was a way to alert friends or contacts if an individual fell off a bike. That's why I came up with this," he added. The system, which uses Arduino sensors coded through C++, connects a sensor to the motorbike. When a person falls off it, it detects the location and relays the information to a contact on its GSM module along with a distress message.

A robot designed by R Riten of VIT International School, which can track and travel along lines drawn on the floor to assist the elderly at home, also grabbed eyeballs. Equipped with three buttons linked to the front door, kitchen, and room, the robot allows users to choose one destination from the three and travels to the spot to fetch or deliver an object. Students came up with prototypes for organic farming and wind-powered trucks that also run on solar panels.



Honourable Minister Meyyanathan Siva presented prizes to Rayyan M.J. (Class 6F) and Kahanshwa S. (Class 6J) at Madras Christian College (MCC) during the LASER 2025 Tech Competition. They secured the 3rd Prize in the category of "Innovation, Technology & Artificial Intelligence". Their project was selected from among 115 entries representing 62 schools across Chennai, Kanchipuram Thiruvallur, and Chengalpattu districts in this District-Level Competition.
